

WASC Senior College and University Commission Requirements for Institutional Websites:

Institutional Mission - WASC Standard 1.1 requires accredited institutions to have a published mission statement - mission can be viewed by clicking on the link <http://www.sonoma.edu/about/mission.html>

Credit Hour Policy - WASC mandates that the institution's credit hour policy be easily accessible - policy on credit hours can be accessed in Catalog Year 16-17 on page 416 <http://www.sonoma.edu/catalog/16-17/17regulations.pdf>

Transfer Credit Policy, Criteria, and Articulation Agreements - In accordance with the U.S. Department of Education Regulation 668.43(a) (11), transfer policy needs to be publicly disclosed. The policy must include criteria regarding transfer of credits, and a list of institutions with which it has established an articulation agreement - policy can be accessed in catalog year 16-17 on page 9 <http://www.sonoma.edu/catalog/16-17/04admissions.pdf>

Student Complaints and Grievance Policy - According to the WSCUC Compliance with Federal Requirements Checklist, the institution's policy needs to be easily accessible - policy and procedures for student complaints and grievances can be accessed in Catalog Year 16-17 on page 426 <http://www.sonoma.edu/catalog/16-17/17regulations.pdf>

Retention and Graduation Rates - WASC Standard 1.2 requires that the institution regularly generates, evaluates, and makes public data about student achievement, including measures of retention and graduation - retention and graduation rates can be accessed on <http://www.sonoma.edu/aa/ra/students/studentbody/ssuretention.html>
