

2.6 *The institution demonstrates that its graduates consistently achieve its stated levels of attainment and ensures that its expectations for student learning are embedded in the standards that faculty use to evaluate student work.*

Evidence:

- The office of [institutional research](#) conducts annual alumni surveys and disseminates this information to departments and administrators. Moreover, many departments also conduct their own [alumni surveys](#) as part of their ongoing assessment strategies.
- Before graduating, all students must demonstrate proficiency in English through passing an examination ([WEPT](#)). The Writing Center administers this exam.
- The general catalog under regulations and policies contains a statement of [grading policy and procedures](#). A student is subject to academic probation if his/her cumulative grade point average falls below 2.0. Graduate and post-baccalaureate students must maintain a 3.0 cumulative grade point average.
