

2.9 *The institution recognizes and promotes appropriate linkages among scholarship, teaching, student learning and service.*

Evidence:

- The Center for Community Engagement supports faculty efforts to include a service-learning component in their classroom. Courses that include such a component are spread throughout the curriculum.
