 - i. Senator Maloney moved to amend the 8th whereas clause to replace the “therefore be it” with “; and”, Seconded by Executive Vice-President Gallino.

 - ii. Senator Maloney moved to add a 9th whereas clause to include, “A large majority of respondents of the AS spring survey stated their support for the idea that signage creates community through awareness that A frame style signs would be an effective way of bringing about that awareness, and that these signs should be a resource for our clubs and organizations to have the ability to reserve.”, Seconded by Senator Butkiewicz.

- iii. Senator Maloney moved to amend the 2nd resolved clause to remove the word, "specifically", Seconded by Senator Barker.

- iv. Senator Maloney moved to amend the 3rd resolved clause to replace the period with a semi colon, also including "and be it further" at the end, Seconded by Senator Barker.

- v. Senator Maloney moved to amend to include a last resolved clause stating, "That this resolution be disseminated to but not limited to, President Arminana, Vice-President of University Affairs and Conflict, Associate Vice-President of Administration and Finance Christopher Venno, Director for Student Center Event Operations Jessica Way and Chartered Student Organizations.", Seconded by Senator Rice.

- vi. Senator Lomeli moved to amend the 1st resolved clause to include, "allowing for A frame style frames" and "for students and student groups, Seconded by Senator Zamora.
 - i Senator Maloney moved to amend the amendment to remove the "allowing for A-frame style frames", Seconded by Senator Bishop.
