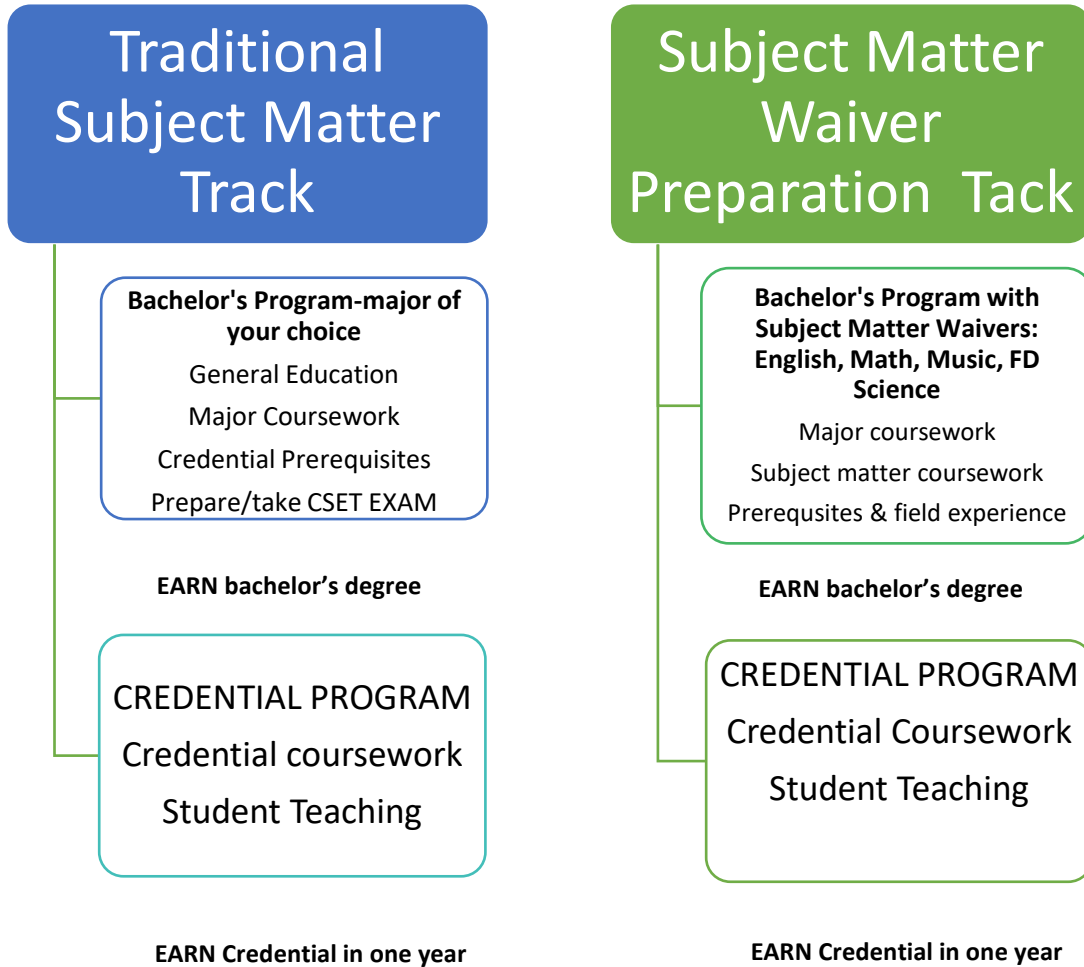


Secondary Teacher Preparation Programs at Sonoma State University
