Travel and Reentry



Every time an international student leaves the U.S., the student will need a valid passport, visa, and I-20 form to reenter. The I-20 must be signed by a designated school official at the Center for International Education **before** leaving the U.S.

Important Information:

- Campus will be CLOSED on Monday, **September 4th** for Labor Day.
- SSALI level placement testing, Orientation, and advising will take place on **August 30 and 31, and September 1.**
- All returning and new SSALI students must check in with Debra Crow by Wednesday, **September 6th**. Make sure you have paid for your health insurance and tuition!

Working During the Academic Term

F-1 students may work up to 20 hours per week on campus during the semester. To work on campus, the student will need to obtain a U.S. Social Security Number. Maintaining Student Status

Below are basic regulations for F-1 Visa students. Failing to maintain legal status could result in serious consequences and may effect the ability to remain in or return to the U.S.

F-1 students must:

- Enroll in and successfully complete 12 units each Fall and Spring Semester.
- Have a valid SEVIS 1-20 from SSU.
- Report any address changes to the Center for International Programs (CIE) within 10 days.
- Have legal permission for any employment.

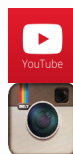
