# WINTER INTER SESSION 2018

## Maximum Units

Winter Intersession courses offer SSU students "units in residence," the same as courses taken during the academic terms. Students may enroll in a maximum of 5 units during Winter Intersession.

## Course Prerequisites

Any course prerequisites are listed in the School of Extended and International Education (SEIE) online catalog ([www.sonoma.edu/exed/catalogs](http://www.sonoma.edu/exed/catalogs)).

It is the student's responsibility to ensure that all course prerequisites are met prior to registering for a class. Failure to meet course prerequisites cannot be accepted as a justification for a refund of fees.

## Fees

## How to Register

Registration is available to SSU students online via MySSU starting October 18. Online registration will be unavailable December 6-11, and then will re-open from December 12 through January 1. To register for classes after that date, you will need to come in to the SEIE Office in Stevenson Hall 1012 or call us at 707-664-2394. Registration closes on January 4. Permission of instructor is required to register after the first class meeting.

## Payment

Payment can be submitted online via MySSU, by phone at 707-664-2394, via U.S. mail, or in-person at Stevenson Hall 1012.

- For SSU students who enroll by December 5, fees are due on December 6.
- For SSU students who enroll between December 12 and January 1, fees are due January 1.
- For Open Door students and SSU students who enroll after January 1, payment is due at the time of enrollment.

## Financial Aid Information

If you would like to defer your Winter Intersession fees and use a portion of your Spring 2018 financial aid, you must fill out the Use of Financial Aid to Defer Fees Approval Form, available in our office or online. You will receive an email via your Seawolf account letting you know if your Deferral has been approved or not. If your deferment is not approved, you will be required to pay your fees by the stated deadlines. All deferment forms must be received by SEIE by November 30.

## Drop and Refund Information

Courses can be dropped via MySSU through January 1, in-person at Stevenson Hall 1012, or by calling 707-664-2394.

Refunds are calculated based on the drop date:

- A 100% refund is granted for classes dropped by January 2
- A 65% refund is granted for classes dropped January 3 or 4
- No refunds are granted for classes dropped on or after January 5
