Room Assignments

All programming provided to our upperclassmen residents living in Beaujolais, Tuscany, and Sauvignon will focus on promoting and enhancing residents familiarity with resources and outlets addressing the needs of continuing students. The core elements in this area will be Career Exploration, Academic Success, Leadership, and Individual Development. **Currently you are only applying to be offered a space on campus and not applying for a specific room type.**

If you are offered a space on campus during our first "round" of offers, you will be able to SELF-SELECT your exact room assignment between March 6-8. Much like registering for classes, you will be given a specific room selection time in which you can log onto the ResidentWeb and select from available rooms. Room selection times are not first come first serve but lottery based. If you are offered a space on campus later on in the process, you will be able to rank a room type preference. Room assignment at that time will be determined by available rooms at the time of the assignment.

**additional information about room selection and roommates will be provided if and when we are able to offer a space.*

Gender Inclusive Living

Gender Inclusive Living would be a great option for those students who identify as lesbian, gay, bisexual, pansexual, queer, asexual, transsexual, and/ or intersex, as well as committed allies. Gender Inclusive spaces will be located in the Sauvignon Apartments for upperclassmen students as this has options for both single, double, and triple bedrooms. In order to be considered for gender inclusive Living you must fill out a short supplemental application in addition to the housing application and receive approval from a Residential Life staff member.

Residents must self-select the Gender Inclusive Living option. Gender Inclusive Living will never be forced upon a student. For Gender-Inclusive placement, roommate pairings will not be based on gender identity, therefore Gender-Inclusive Living allows roommate pairings regardless of the gender with which a student does or does not identify. Thus, residents of Gender-Inclusive Living may request any roommate.

This is not a "co-ed" residence or a place for romantic couples to live together.

Special Consideration for Accommodation

If you believe you may need an accommodation for a disability/functional limitation, you will need to contact the Disability Services for Students Office at 707-664-2677. The DSS office is committed to ensuring that all students with disabilities/functional limitations have equal access to the educational environment at Sonoma State University.

Rooms are furnished with a raised extra-long twin bed, lofted beds and/or bunk beds, depending on the room configuration and room type. Most bathrooms have a tub/shower combo with sliding shower door that a resident will step in to.

Some examples of accommodations include but are not limited to: ADA compliant bathroom, automatic door opener, strobe light fire alarm/ smoke alarm, visual door bell (typically for hearing impaired residents), private bathroom, access to kitchen and ground floor.

Please note that the process for requesting a non-standard room is independent of the housing preference process and student must obtain *recommendation* from the DSS Office prior to February 21, 2018. Please contact the DSS office at 707-664-2677 for more information on services they provide and resources for SSU students.
