Student Instructions:

- MS-CES Students must register for regularly scheduled CES courses through the online registration system.
- Any 300/400 level courses taken to meet pre-requisites (i.e., not for credit towards the unit requirements of the MS-CES degree) can only be added via the regular Open University process. Open University courses taken to meet pre-requisite requirements may not be re-taken for graduate credit at a later time. Instructors for Open University will not be provided additional compensation for Open University enrollment.
- Current SSU degree-seeking students must list their sonoma.edu e-address. Private emails cannot be used for University business.
- The student should fill in this form completely before seeking signatures.
- In order to register, students must submit a separate SEIE Fee Payment Form along with this MS-CES Special Studies Registration Form to SEIE. *SEIE must have both forms in order to register you in the class; please turn them in together as we cannot be responsible for wayward forms.*
