THE DEPARTMENT

At present, the Department is comprised of six full-time permanent faculty members as well as several part-time lecturers. The Department is seeking interested candidates for a lecturer pool for temporary part-time and full-time work. Workload may vary from semester to semester as needed to meet the demands of course sections.

DUTIES OF THE POSITION

The Department of Sociology anticipates hiring temporary part-time lecturers to teach courses in one or more of the following areas: (1) core areas, including introduction to sociology, sociological research methods, statistics, and sociological theory; (2) elective areas, including race & ethnicity, emotions, aging, environment, religion, social psychology, socialization, social interaction, career planning, gender, drugs, families, urban, political sociology, power, demography, culture, social movements, childhood & adolescence, social work & social welfare, work, organizations, social policy, stratification, and science & technology; and (3) additional areas of sociological specialization. Lecturers are expected to teach courses that follow department requirements for course format/content, as well as to follow university course requirements. Lecturers are expected hold posted in-person office hours of one (1) hour per week per course.

PROFESSIONAL QUALIFICATIONS

To be recommended for appointment, the candidate must have:

Required:

- Master's degree in sociology or a related field
- At least one semester/quarter of teaching experience

Preferred:

- Ph.D. / Ph.D. candidacy in sociology or a related field
- Recent extensive undergraduate teaching experience

RANK AND SALARY

Full-time is 15-unit workload per semester. Actual salary is dependent upon number of units assigned, educational preparation, and availability of funds subject to any CSU system faculty contract salary increases.

- Selection as a candidate in the applicant pool, does not guarantee employment. Temporary Faculty appointments are made on a part-time, temporary basis and contingent upon department needs and funding.
- Temporary Faculty appointments are made on a semester-by-semester basis.
- Relocation expenses will not be provided for temporary faculty appointments.
- Expenses incurred to attend an interview for temporary faculty positions are not reimbursed by the University.

If you have not applied for a job at Sonoma State University previously you will be asked to *Register Now* in order to proceed. At the initial stage of the application, you will be prompted to upload a resume. Please combine your CV and cover letter into one PDF document and upload it in place of the resume. Official transcripts are required at the time of hire.

Application procedures for temporary faculty already teaching in the department:

- Temporary Faculty with three-year contracts do not need to reapply.
- Temporary Faculty who have taught for the department within the past two years only need to submit a letter of intent to remain in the pool. The hiring committee will review the Personnel Action File and then determine whether an additional interview would be beneficial.

Sonoma State University hires only individuals lawfully authorized to work in the United States. All offers of employment are contingent upon presentation of documents demonstrating the appointee's identity and eligibility to work, in accordance with the provisions of the Immigration Reform and Control Act. **Sonoma State University does not facilitate the process of applying for an H1B Visa for temporary positions.**
